If a license upgrade is your goal, we wish you success in your studies, and that you will find them fun and educational. How about Morse code? If you're planning to set aside more time to learn the characters and improve your speed in copying, sometimes choosing the right tool can help you stay on track. LD / W0XLD recommends "Learn" CW Online" at https://lcwo.net, a website that provides a highly-configurable set of tools to teach and drill however works best for you. Since it's on the web, it works on all operating systems and platforms. It's also open source, so if you run a server at home, you can even run your own private instance for yourself, family, and friends. Try learning all the characters with the Koch method, and configure the speed drills to your preference by adjusting Farnsworth spacing.

If you're into digital voice modes, perhaps you may already have a digital-mode hot spot connecting your DMR, YSF, or D-Star radio to the world through the internet. Ken / K0KWH has pointed us to a new software project called "WPSD," which is a fork and upgrade from the original PiStar dashboard software. It has become a much-loved standalone software project with a new look and lots of new features. It has an active development community building around it, so new features and fixes are being added quickly. If you already have a Raspberry Pi hot spot, a BridgeCom SkyBridge MAX/Plus, a DVMega, or ZUMSpot hot spot, take a look at the project's homepage at https://w0chp.radio/wpsd/ to see if they have an image for your device.
